

WORKSHOP 4: GATHERING THE KINGDOM

Purpose: To gather all identified community organizations/resources into one space to:

- Validate the community Strengths, Weaknesses, Opportunities and Threats
- (SWOT)
- Validate community needs assessment
- Begin to establish the church as the hub in the community

Audience:

- Contacts from research -Resource Agencies, Educators, Administrators,
- Politicians, Social Organizations
- Police Chief, Local Council, Mayor, Fire Chief
- Health Department

Invitation:

- Invitation via email or mail.
- Clarify purpose and explain what will take place and how long.
- If time permits a verbal invitation with written follow-up or with friendly
- reminder.

Types of Gatherings:

- Informal lunch, dinner, coffee hour, etc.
- Join an existing meeting like Board of Education SIAC meeting, Health
- Department meeting of department heads.
- Meet as a cluster of churches together with identified resources.

Gathering Agenda Example:

- Welcome and purpose
- Eat and greet
- Review S.W.O.T., and Community Needs
- You may want to give opportunities to community organizations to introduce
- themselves

Follow-up:

- Thank you sent.
- Include church information sheet (see sample)

Invitation to possible second gathering:

• Social, Movie, Bowling, Football or other sporting events.
